# General Terms of Business

## 1. Application

The general terms of business specified below apply to the legal relations between Stiftung Deutsche Klinik für Diagnostik GmbH (hereinafter referred to as DKD) and the other signatories to the agreement regarding all inpatient and outpatient services of DKD and their staff. They also apply to services on behalf DKD rendered by third parties and for any later examinations or therapies.

## 2. Extent of the examination and treatment Program

Unless otherwise provided in an individual case, there will be a special examination or detailed first examination with interview. Subsequent to and based on that examination, the extent of the stipulated program of examinations or treatment is laid down with the patient by mutual agreement.

## 3. Appointments

DKD takes great effort to arrange for appointments according to patients' requests and to keep the times indicated - under reserve of changes for medical or organizational reasons. In such case the patient will be informed as soon as possible. The patient is obliged to keep the appointment and to be on time save for being avoidably prevented from doing so by act of God.

## 4. Medical Report /Medical Secrecy

The medical report will be written in the German language and shall only be addressed to persons named by the patient. Consultant reports, X-ray films, clinically relevant findings, originals or copies of photographic documents will only be sent or given to the first person named by the patient. Translations into other languages and additional copies of X-ray films will be taken care of as within the bounds of possibility, and they are invoiced additionally. If examinations are carried out by order of the Public Health Commission, or a pension insurer, or professional corporation, the aforementioned shall also receive a copy of the medical report. Physicians of DKD may make use of patient data as deemed necessary for the purpose of medical training, continuous education or research in the hospital.

## 5. Hospital Regulations - Rules of the house

By domiciliary right, DKD is entitled to issue rules of the house and to make them obligatory upon the patients.

## 6. Liability

DKD shall be held liable only in terms of agreement and in case of unauthorized action with intent or

gross negligence on the part of DKD-employees. This limitation of liability also holds good inasmuch as DKD engages third parties to perform services ensuing from this agreement.

## 7. Remunerations /payments

The calculation of DKD's services is subject to the legal stipulations and the agreements concluded to that effect. Other than that outpatient services are liquidated pursuant to "Gebührenordnung für Ärzte (GOÄ)" meaning a nationwide fee schedule for physicians, as currently in force.

If parties liable for costs or other third parties (a private health insurance for instance) refuse reimbursement and/or payment of the costs incurred, the patient and/or other contracting partners of DKD consent to paying the uncovered costs of treatment out of their own pocket.

## 8. Cost information

Since the final amount depends on the extent and number of examinations or treatments performed as might be required in the individual case, binding cost accounts can only be made for the basic programs of a check-up. Cost estimates regarding additional examinations aside from the basic program, special examinations, evaluation or treatment of diagnostic problems and hospitalizations are without commitment unless previously explicitly agreed upon as binding. There is no commitment of DKD's own accord to pass on the information that the conveyed cost estimate might possibly be overrun.

## 9. Terms of payment

Payments are due immediately and without rebate. This also holds true for interim bills. DKD requests appropriate advance payments and may condition upon payment to start or to continue examinations and treatment.

## 10. Applicable law and place of jurisdiction

All legal relations between the contracting partners are exclusively subject to German law as applicable at the domicile of DKD. Place of jurisdiction is Wiesbaden if DKD's contracting partner is

- A general merchant
- A juridical person of Public Law or of separate property under power of public law.

## 11. Services by third parties

Inasmuch as may be deemed necessary in the interest of an individual patient, third parties may be involved in rendering the services the patient is entitled to.
